Update as of Wednesday, August 25, 2010:

Access to Independence is our new community-based model for adults currently attending Life Skills, CIP, CIP/WAP, Special Needs and Senior Services.

Select services including participants scheduled to be at the Learning & Employment Campus Mid in Burlingame will begin their new programs on Monday, August 30.

Only participants that are scheduled to participate at the Learning & Employment Campus Mid County, including select Community Access enrollees and select youth from Transition Program for Young Adults will begin their new program on Monday, August 30.

The Learning & Employment Campus Mid is located at 1606 Rollins Rd, Burlingame. Community Access meeting sites are located throughout the county including this location. Participants and families will be notified individually of their location.

Participants enrolled to attend programs at South County Campus will remain at their current location. Participants enrolled at the North County site in Daly City will continue their current programs and not be affected.

Select youth enrolled in our **Transition Program for Young Adults** will also begin meeting at this location. Youth currently meeting in South San Francisco will continue at their current location.
